Team Background and Update

The Pinellas County Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team began reviewing cases July 2000. The team meets every third Thursday from 9am – 11am, except for the month of December. Team membership includes representatives from the local police departments, sheriff's department, State Attorney's office, local domestic violence centers, family service centers, batterers intervention services, Clerk of Courts, Office of the Court Administrator, and the Health Department. On average, 25 – 30 people participate in each review; however, there is a core group of about 15 members that attend every review.

The team has completed nine reviews. Cases are selected from a document provided by the Medical Examiner's Office listing all homicides from 1996 to present. The State Attorney's Office reviewed the list and determined which cases were domestic violence related. Each meeting the team selects 3-4 cases from the list for potential review. The State Attorney's Office researches each of the cases to confirm that they are closed. Through this process the team selects two closed cases to review each meeting. The team only reviews intimate partner homicide. Team members are asked to research the case and bring relevant agency information to the next review. Each member gives a verbal report of the case information and documents are not shared or duplicated. Each member leaves with the information they brought to the review. A Confidentiality Statement is part of the sign in sheet that participants sign at each meeting. The team has not formally compiled or released any findings.

Funding

The Pinellas County Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team does not receive any funding and is hoping that the State decides to fund teams in the future. Specifically, the team needs funding for a position to investigate the cases, collect information, and organize the meetings. Currently, the team does not have the ability to conduct an elaborate search for case information.

Emerging Issues

Contacting Family Members – The team has decided not to contact family members. Contacting family members is a very sensitive issue and may be difficult for the survivors. In addition, if family members were contacted it would be important to provide follow-up services which the team is not prepared to do. It is very important that

police interview family members at the time of the homicide, especially regarding history of relationship and domestic violence. Interviews with family members would then be available in the police file.

Working with the Media – The team has never contacted the media directly. The media does receive copies of the minutes from the DV Council Meeting that discusses the formation of the fatality review team. To date, the media has not contacted the team.

Impact of Legislation – The legislation was critical for Pinellas County. Both the State Attorney's Office and the police department would not participate in reviews until the legislation passed. Now that the legislation has passed, everyone is on board and participating in the reviews.

Problems and Obstacles

Suspicions of Research – Many of the team members were reluctant to participate because they felt like the process was just about research and academics. This issue has been resolved.

Case Research – Without funding it is difficult to conduct a thorough investigation of each case. Team members do not have the time or resources to conduct an elaborate information search on each case.

Impact of Fatality Review

The Pinellas County Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team feels that the process of fatality review has already had an impact in their community.

- New collaborations have been formed, especially with people and agencies who were not traditionally involved or at the table. For example, prior to the formation of the fatality review team, the Felony Division of the State Attorney's Office was not very active on the issue of domestic violence. Since becoming members of the fatality review team, new collaborations have been formed and new lines of communication have been opened.
- Pinellas County's coordinated community response has improved.
- The process of fatality review has been an educational process for members who are not typically exposed to the issue of domestic violence.
- The process of fatality review has revitalized many of the people who do this work every day.
- The community can learn from the findings in a non-threatening way and improve systems response to domestic violence. Fatality review has already helped identify the following:
 - Law enforcement has an opportunity to educate the perpetrator during an arrest. Law enforcement usually spends time talking with the perpetrator while driving from the crime scene to the police department. In addition, the perpetrator is a captive audience while in the holding cell. A VCR has been set-up in the Sheriff's holding cell and domestic violence education videos are

- played while perpetrators are in the cell. This issue is also going to be addressed in police training.
- When a teenager is consistently truant or is a runaway, this may be an indicator of a larger problem in the home, possibly domestic violence. It is important that appropriate services are provided for these teenagers. The teenager may also be a possible inroad into the family. It is also important to improve legal options for teenagers.
- The people responding to domestic violence must be culturally competent and sensitive.
- Currently, there is no consistent system in place to follow-up on perpetrators who are ordered to treatment. Also, if a perpetrator is put on probation and then re-offends before the order is put into the computer, the perpetrator is usually not charged with a violation of probation. A system needs to be put in place to track and monitor perpetrators more effectively. Judges need to be trained to take probation and violations of protection orders more seriously in matters of domestic violence cases.

The meeting was held at Largo Police Dept., 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

Linda Osmundson, CASA, reviewed the purpose(s) of a Fatality Review Team, specifically prevention of future domestic violence related deaths, identifying gaps in the system, identifying trends.

Frieda Widera, The Haven of RCS, reviewed the work and varied efforts which led to this first meeting.

Discussion regarding some agencies being unsure as to their ultimate level of involvement. Several members gathering information to take back to departments for discussion. Since some members unsure, group agreed to proceed with discussion as IF we were committed to process. With that in mind, the group envisions that the Fatality Review Team would operate in the following manner:

- The Pinellas County Domestic Violence Task Force will serve as the Advisory Board or Group to the Fatality Review Team. The Team is a subcommittee of the larger Task Force.
- Will look at violence in intimate relationships only (to start, may broaden at a later time if all agree to)
- Will not reopen investigation

- Look at 1996 cases forward
- Only review closed cases
- Will look at murder/suicides
- Will consider all domestic violence related homicides
- Will not interview friends, family, or neighbors in process of review
- Will be closed to the media
- Will review confidentiality statements
- No blame will be assigned
- Will meet once per month (third Thursday of month) at Family Service Centers location on Roosevelt Blvd., 9:00 am. (next two meetings are NOT on third Thursday due to lack of room availability, they are scheduled for 6/22/00 and 7/13/00).
- Will ask homicide detective from appropriate agency to come in and present case if at all possible
- Will review one case at the next meeting and see how much time it takes, what questions we will want to address, etc.

Frieda Widera will pull together some examples of confidentiality statements for group to review at next meeting, request that Bill Holmes, Pinellas Park Police Dept. bring the computer provided to team to next meeting, and send out the newly passed Fatality Review Team legislation to everyone to review.

Beverly Andringa, State Attorney's Office, agreed to provide an overview/review of the Fatality Review Team legislation at the next meeting.

Larry Weiland, Pinellas County Sheriff's Dept., and Michael Puetz, St. Petersburg Police Dept., offered to bring the first case for review. It is a murder/suicide which involved both agencies (Madiera Beach, St. Petersburg). All team members are asked to bring any information they have on Maryanne Jordan, female with DOB 01/08/43 or Roger Davis, male with DOB 03/04/55.

Beverly Andringa, State Attorney's Office, reviewed the Fatality Review Team legislation which passed during the session (Senate bill 1039, House bill 1037-rider). Governor Bush signed the legislation and it takes effect 07/01/00. Beverly pointed out that the legislation includes the medical examiner and members of the business community as entities to be involved on the team. Teams are formed locally. Bill mandates that records be kept in a specific format for FDLE, format to be provided by FDLE. Outlines purpose and goals. Indicates that the Governor's Task Force is to provide technical assistance. Members are immune from liability if they come in to discuss in good faith. What team creates as a group is confidential, what is brought in as facts from agencies is not. States that near fatal incidents can be reviewed too.

Detective Jim Beining, PCSO, presented homicide case information on Maryanne Jordan. Detective Cindra Leedy, St. Petersburg Police Dept., presented information on linked suicide case, Roger Davis. The team asked misc. questions and pondered some steps aimed at fine tuning system. Team would like complete names of involved parties for future case reviews so that thorough checks for information can be accomplished. Want to invite representatives from larger hospitals in area that provide indigent care.

Frieda Widera encouraged members to review the provided examples of confidentiality statements and come to the next meeting prepared to discuss what ours will look like. Suggestion to combine the sign-in sheet and confidentiality agreement into one form.

Discussion regarding dates of upcoming meetings. Due to an error in previous minutes, room was reserved for third Thursday versus second Thursday as originally agreed upon. Second Thursday no longer available. Group decided to change ongoing meeting time to the third Thursday of each month, 9:00 am to 11:00 am, at Family Service Centers. There will be no meeting during the month of December due to holidays.

Decided to do two cases for future meetings. At end of each meeting, Frieda will recap what trends or issues the group brought up as part of case review and discussion. These items will also be included in the minutes.

Decision to utilize a combination sign-in sheet and confidentiality statement. Frieda will bring to next meeting. Group agreed that members who take notes during case reviews will either list no identifying information on sheets or will hand all notes to Victoria Schaus, Family Service Centers, to shred upon conclusion of meeting.

Detective Mike Madden, PCSO, presented homicide case information on Raymond Schneider.

Issues/trends identified during this review: 1. Further training on domestic violence issues with psychiatrists and individuals who respond to suicide calls or provide intervention services to suicidal clients needed. 2. Ask local law enforcement about their procedures on peace calls, particularly if

caller reports threats of violence. 3. Continue and enhance education in school system to break cycle of violence for youth. 4. Encourage and/or recommend that children involved in homes where domestic violence fatality occurred access counseling services.

Issues/trends identified during review on 06/22/00: 1. Potential need for a community hotline for batterers. 2. Need for more prevention work. One such area might be domestic violence centers working with local law enforcement to identify geographical areas where residents "hang out" (often with alcohol use) consistently and do additional outreach to the areas (posters in laundry rooms and community centers, brochures for community police officers, letters and brochures to residents involved in "family troubles" or "verbal disputes"). 3. During police training encourage officers to utilize ride to jail as a seed planting time when arresting for domestic violence, violations, etc. (tell arrestee that there are counseling resources in the area, how to access them). 4. Need medical personnel participating in review too, maybe bigger hospitals that provide indigent care.

The meeting was held at Family Service Centers, 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

Frieda Widera shared update on recent meeting with Florida Department of Law Enforcement staff responsible for annual report on the work of state's fatality review teams. FDLE staff expect to have data gathering form completed by the end of the year. Will be demographic and fact finding (key indicators) in nature versus specific and overly complicated. They also shared that they would like the 2002 report to be based on deaths/cases in 2001. Members present discussed pros and cons of reviewing non-closed cases. Frieda agreed to contact other teams for feedback. FDLE will be sending out a list of the fatality review teams in Florida with contact information. Frieda will share with the group as soon as it is received.

Linda Osmundson shared that a representative from the Clerk's Office will attend the next meeting.

Detective Rob Snipes, PCSO, presented homicide case information on Karen Tolomei. Case involved multiple contacts in our system: law enforcement, Batterer Intervention Program (BIP), civil court, probation, hospital (Baker Act).

Issues/trends identified during this review: 1. Need a method for system to respond more quickly when there are red flags via reoffending. 2. Entire system needs to start referring to BIPs as a consequence versus a cure. 3. Need to limit the number of times an abuser can attend a BIP (similar to limitation for driver improvement course after getting a speeding ticket). 4.

Look at increasing required number of BIP sessions during sentencing. 5. Encourage judges to sentence abusers to jail if they don't "pass" the BIP. 6. Have law enforcement notify probation about subsequent arrest, as well as charge with violation of probationary terms. To accomplish this, suggestion to have a computer with CJIS hook-up available to officers/deputies at booking. Staff the computer with a volunteer who looks up probation conditions, alerts probation office about new arrest. Attach a form to arrest affidavit which alerts SAO that probation has been notified. 7. Look at how to identify when violation of no contact order is occurring and impose consequences consistently. 8. Develop a timely way for BIP providers to notify probation office when abusers do not show-up for initial orientation or first class. 9. Keep data on income level (low, middle, upper) for cases being reviewed to see if any trends/patterns.

Frieda Widera shared with group that she has not yet contacted other Fatality Review Teams regarding the issue of reviewing open cases (in response to FDLE's proposal for 2001 report). She will attempt contact and update the group at the next meeting.

Officer William Holmes, Pinellas Park Police Dept., presented homicide/suicide information on Mildred A. Dowds and Sebastian Pereira. Case did not include any other agency contacts.

Issues/trends identified during this review: 1. Increase Outreach to senior populations. Marketing strategy might be talking about new relationships since many seniors have deceased spouses and may potentially be entering into new romances. 2. Need to find out if Pinellas County has closed the loop hole for someone to purchase a gun at a gun show without a background check. 3. Invite medical professionals to participate on Fatality Review Team. Wendy Loomas agreed to contact Bayfront Medical Center. William Holmes agreed to contact EMS (he also agreed to contact PEMHS which was one of areas identified during a previous review). 4. Make literature on domestic violence available in hospital emergency department waiting rooms. 4. Train Helpline phone staff to address batterer issues that callers may have. Recruit individuals who would assist with calls as needed. Frieda agreed to forward to the Batterer Intervention Providers

Subcommittee to discuss feasibility and how to implement. 5. More Outreach to the Hispanic community.

St. Petersburg Police Dept. was detained. Information on the second homicide case with Julia Brinckerhoff as victim was discussed by Beverly Andringa from the State Attorney's Office and Gay Inskeep from the Administrative Office of the Courts. Note: victim was 15 years old at time of homicide and had an infant child.

Issues/trends identified during this review. 1. Educate attorneys about injunction options, child abuse reports (encourage to routinely ask age of father in teen pregnancy cases and report when father is an adult), refer them to American Bar Assn website for information of domestic violence. Gay Inskeep offered to include something in an upcoming St. Pete Bar newsletter. Linda Osmundson agreed to write an article for the newsletter. Frieda agreed to contact the Clearwater Bar and offer services as a luncheon speaker. 2. Begin to look at system inadequacies related to youth in domestic violence situations (ex. adolescent males battering parents). 3. Look at legislative efforts to get help to dysfunctional families (ex. rest of children in perpetrator's home of origin). Linda Osmundson agreed to contact the Asian FACE center regarding this particular family. 4. Provide follow-up to victim's family when they are going to be raising a grandchild. Offer resources on issues like parenting skills, identifying abusive relationships, and legal remedies. 5. Get information on dating violence to parents in the community. One option is to network with police officers who address youth truancy issues.

The meeting was held at Family Service Centers, 9:00 am to 11:20 am.

Frieda Widera updated group that she has not yet heard back from other teams regarding open versus closed cases discussion. Frieda also shared a brief article regarding Jacksonville's Fatality Review Team results. Of particular note, in 45% of their cases, there was only one opportunity for the criminal justice system to intervene before a homicide occurred. Also, in 58% of the cases there was a clearly documented prior history of arrests for domestic violence.

Tony Guagnini shared information on his efforts to set-up a probation person and computer at the jail. A probation officer or paraprofessional will determine if the arrestee is already under supervision so that a violation of probation charge can be added to arrest affidavit. Jail in on-line and ready to go. Will work for felony supervision cases but not misdemeanor. Hoping Salvation Army can provide access to system to do misdemeanors too. Frieda agreed to contact Salvation Army regarding this.

Detective Bob Gellatly, Tarpon Spring Police Dept., presented homicide/suicide information on Domna A. Simoulidis and Michael Simoulidis.

Issues/trends identified during this review: 1. Encourage people in the community to refer victims to domestic violence centers to conduct lethality assessments and safety planning. 2. Domestic violence centers look at culturally specific outreach to communities that tend to be closed to outsiders. Look at different and creative ways of doing versus traditional methods. 3. Continue to emphasize education in schools. 4. Look at requiring family law attorneys to have domestic violence training-specifically in recognizing that divorce in a domestic violence relationship is not the norm and an extremely dangerous time for victims.

Detective John Diebel, Clearwater Police Dept., presented homicide information on Brenda Ruth Julien. Case involved multiple contacts in our system: law enforcement, State Attorney's Office, Salvation Army Probation, Clerk of Circuit Court.

Issues/trends identified during review: 1. Attempt some intervention in runaway teen families to determine what's going on in family. 2. Look at identification of "domestic predators" and share information in system. 3. Look at identifying individuals who won't benefit from Batterer Intervention Programs and need to just go to jail.

Fatality Review Team Meeting November 16, 2000



- 1) Re: Tampa meeting on December 11 and 12 Victoria Schaus would like to be added to list if slot is available.
- 2 Linda Osmundson report re: FDLE data gathering:
 - a) FDLE would like any data that the team has collected so far.
 - b) Would like team to review "Data Submission" form and critique it using the "Fatality Review Team Critique Form."
 - c) Send completed critique form to Frieda by November 30, 2000 to be coordinated for submission to FDLE.
 - d) Things to look for in form- is it user-friendly? Is it something that can be loaded into a laptop and easily filled in during meetings?
 - e) Linda Amidei suggested giving copy of FDLE forms to researchers who developed current form for their review and comments.
- 3) Issue re: reviewing closed vs. open cases. Gay Inskeep, acting chair, read Frieda's notes from contacts with other teams. Fred Schaub offered his comments from the State Attorney's perspective, and said that he was strongly opposed to the team reviewing open cases. He felt that such a review might jeopardize an open case, since the statute only provides confidentiality in civil proceedings, not criminal. This means that any member of the team could potentially receive a subpoena to testify in a criminal trial about what was said and done during a fatality review meeting. Those team members present agreed that we should continue our policy of reviewing closed cases only since we are concerned with trends rather than focusing on specific facts. Gay Inskeep did not feel comfortable going forward with a formal vote in the absence of the "official" chair, so the team vote on this issue was postponed until the January 18, 2001 meeting.
- 4) Tom Kline from the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office and Steve McMullen from Largo Police Department presented their cases. There were no areas of possible intervention identified by the group in the Sheriff's Office case. Suggested interventions in the Largo case were 1) improved lawyer education (Linda Osmundson will draft an article for publication in the local bar association newsletter) and 2) domestic violence screening on the part of the school system and the Department of Juvenile Justice. Gay Inskeep commented that if school or DJJ personnel receive information from a child that he/she witnessed domestic violence in the home, there is probably an obligation to report such to the statewide abuse hotline. Linda Osmundson observed that only one of the cases the team has reviewed so far had contact with domestic violence resources/agencies prior to the homicide. Linda Amidei pointed out the flip side of that issue which is that perhaps the people that are having contact with the system aren't victims of homicides because of the system's help.
- 5) The next cases to be reviewed (potentially) are Linda White (#173), Elizabeth McKenna (#188), and Dennis Lyttle (#39). Frieda Widera will check into the feasibility of reviewing two of these cases, and will distribute further identifying information to the team.
