

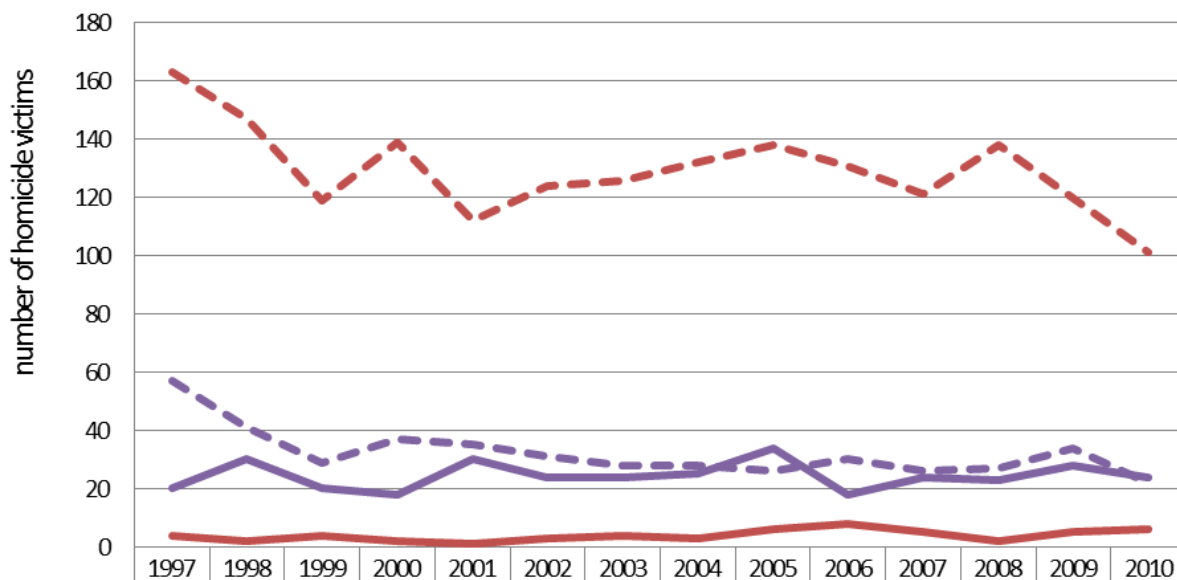
Domestic Violence Homicide Rates in Washington State, 1997-2010

The charts below compare the rates of domestic violence victim homicides to all other homicides in Washington State from 1997 through 2010. Domestic violence victim homicides are those in which the person killed was a domestic violence victim killed by a current or former intimate partner, or someone acting on behalf of the victim's current or former partner.¹ These deaths do not include abusers killed by domestic violence victims. Other homicides include victims of all ages killed by any other perpetrator.²

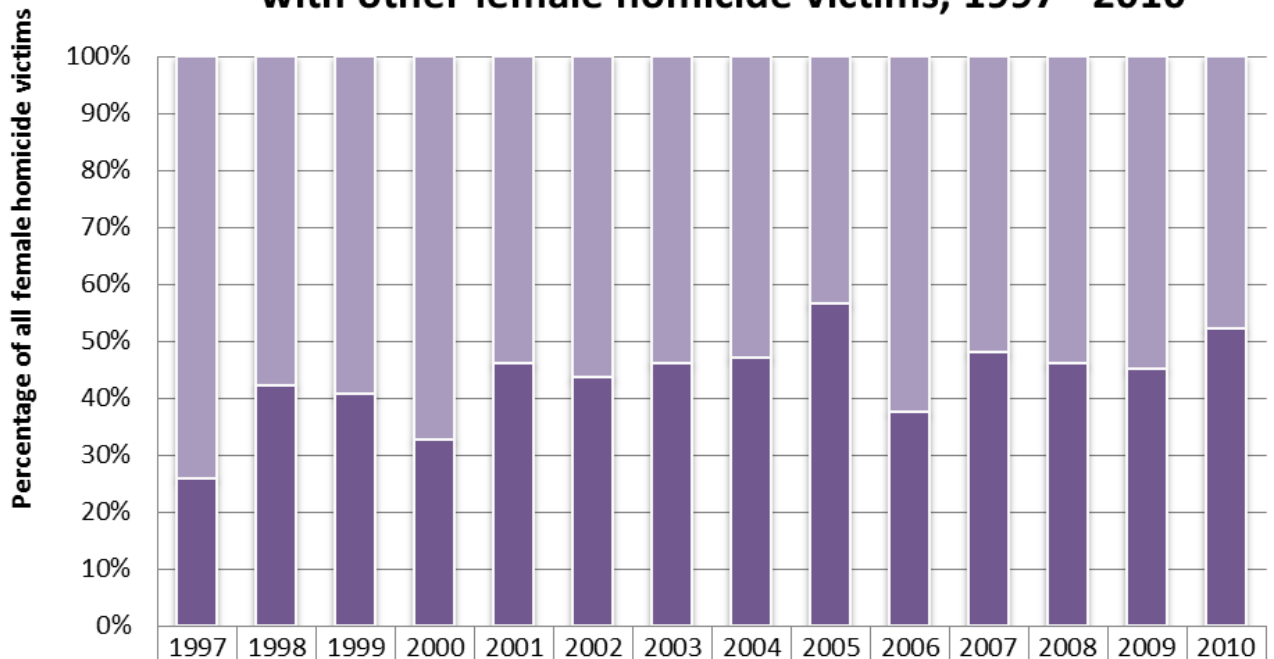

Domestic violence victim homicides compared with all other homicides, 1997-2010



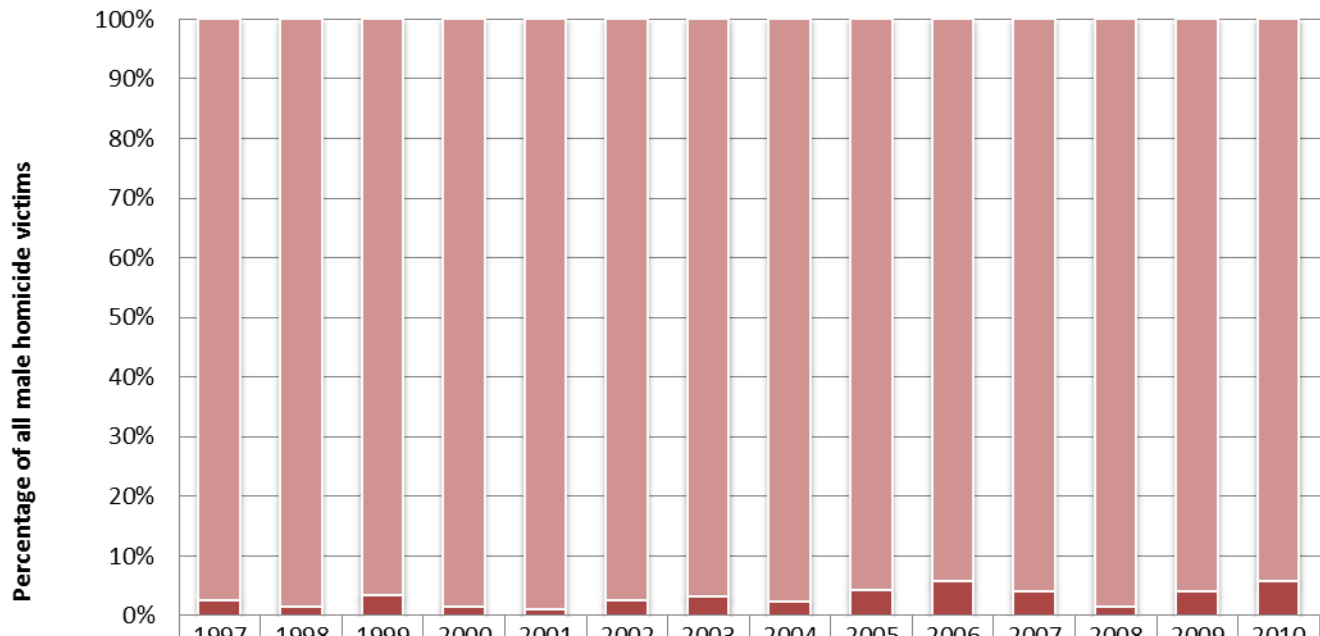
